- Visit to the Christmas market and festive sweets shops in the city centre, where we will see the Christmas lights and decorations.



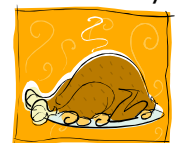
Thursday 21st December

- Workshop on Spanish Christmas Carols: We will sing traditional Spanish carols and we will also learn carols from other countries.



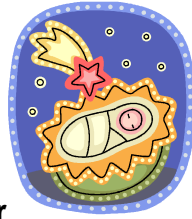
Friday 22nd December
