The Junior Day Programme provides an ideal supplement to a family holiday for teenage children. Teenagers can learn English, socialise with other students from around the world, and take part in an action packed activity programme.

Ages: 13 - 17 years

Spring Programme Available: 18 April – 29 April

Summer Programme Available: 13 June – 26 August

Autumn Programme Available: 10 October – 4 November

Courses start every Monday

A Learning Experience

Students study English with other EC students at one of our junior centres. On the first day of school students will sit for a placement test in order to assess their level of English language proficiency. Students will then join a class with students who have a similar level of English. Our teachers make the course interesting and fun with lessons planned around topics designed to stimulate young people.

The Programme

Families must arrange to stay in accommodation which is situated near the EC bus route (Sliema & St Julian's area). Students will be notified of the nearest EC bus stop upon booking. In the morning students are picked up by a private EC bus to attend lessons. On the first Monday of their course, students are picked up by the private EC bus from EC's Adult Centre in St Julians at 7:30. After lunch students who have booked to attend the activity programme will be taken directly to afternoon activities. Following the afternoon activity, students will be returned to their bus stop by the private EC bus to join their family. Junior Day programme students will also attend evening and weekend activities, unless parental permission to miss such activities is provided.

Important

It is important that when bookings are made, EC is provided with the address of the student's accommodation. This way a student Welcome Pack including information about the school / classes and activity times can be delivered to the student.

Included

- English Course 20 lessons (45 minutes each) per week Maximum 15 students per class
- Course Materials (students should bring their own notebook & pen)
- EC school bus for lessons and activities
- Afternoon, evening and weekend activity programme
- Packed lunch
- Airport transfer (arrival & departure) when accommodation is also booked through EC Malta





After School

The Junior Classic Day Programme can be booked **with or without** activities. For those students who would like to join activities a full varied programme is available. A private EC bus service takes students to and from activities. Those students who do not join the activity programme will be dropped back to their EC bus-stop after lunch.

Extra Activities

Diving:

Students can opt to follow a scuba diving course leading to an internationally recognised PADI qualification. Our dive centre offers the PADI Open Waters for beginners and the PADI Advanced course for more experienced divers. The course replaces some afternoon activities and is completed in 4 half day sessions.

Sailing:

Students can choose to learn or to perfect their sailing techniques, leading to an internationally recognised RYA qualification. Students will not be able to attend all scheduled activities since they will spend 4 half day sessions sailing with our experienced instructors.

Sicily Trip:

Malta's location, just 94 kms south of Sicily, makes visiting the Italian island very easy. The trip departs early Sunday morning and returns on Sunday night, with a guided tour including Mount Etna.

Welfare, Rules and Disciplinary Action

Customer Complaints

At EC, we endeavour to provide our students with the highest possible level of service. If, however, a student is unsatisfied with any aspect of their programme with EC, we ask that they inform us immediately. Most problems are small and can be quickly resolved by our staff members. During the first week of school, all students are given an Initial Course Evaluation form, in which they are asked to evaluate various aspects of their stay, such as tuition, accommodation and leisure. The form also allows students the opportunity to bring to our attention anything that is not to their satisfaction should they feel unable to speak to us directly. Solutions to any issues will be provided and all necessary parties will be notified when applicable. Students are also requested to complete an End of Course Evaluation form at the end of their stay such that they have the opportunity to provide EC with general feedback before returning to their home country.

Course Certificate

Students must attend all lessons and organised activities in order to receive their End of Course Certificate

Alcohol Consumption

The consumption of alcohol by Junior students is not allowed. Students who consume alcohol risk being expelled from EC and repatriated to their home country at their own expense.

Drugs

The consumption and / or possession of any illegal drugs will result in the immediate expulsion and repatriation of the student at their own expense. The intervention of the police may also be necessary in such an event.

Smoking

The legal age for smoking in Malta is 16 years.

Expulsion

EC reserves the right to expel and repatriate a student at his / her own expense for any of the reasons including but not limited to the circumstances listed below:

- Possession and / or use of any illegal drugs
- Consumption of alcohol
- Malicious damage to school property and/or place of accommodation
- Being a danger to his / her own safety or that of other students
- Breaking Maltese law
- Repeated failure to attend academic lessons

In any of the above circumstances the student will be informed that their stay is going to be terminated with immediate effect. Simultaneously EC will inform the student's agent about the student's behaviour and the course of action to be taken. The earliest flight available will be booked and an EC staff member will accompany the student to the airport to ensure that the student leaves the country safely. Following such action EC will terminate all relationships with the student and will be unable to take further responsibility for him or her. No refunds will be given to any student who has been expelled.
