General Internship Aims

- To provide practical work experience in companies for students and professionals

- Provide an individual with the means to improve upon business language and interpersonal communication skills and to meet individual requirements in terms of vocabulary extension within a specified vocational area

Internships

Internships allow students to improve their English in a specific profession, gain practical skills and increase their awareness of international business practices.

We provide the opportunity for students to gain unpaid work experience in a wide range of industries and occupations including: Sales & Marketing, Finance, PR & Advertising, Human Resources, Law, Engineering, Travel & Tourism, Hotel & Catering, Finance & Accounting, Insurance, Administration & Secretarial.

The English Course

Before beginning their placement students will attend an English course, which provides a great opportunity for them to get used to life in a new country and helps them build their confidence using English before starting their internship.

All Nationalities - Minimum Course Duration: 4 weeks before beginning internship.

Requirements

EU and Non-EU students will not need a work permit because there is no remuneration and in most cases the work placement is to enhance the studies or form part of the course. Students that require a Visa though will need it for the whole duration.

Notes:

- Applications must be received minimum 2 months prior to arrival
- Interviews may take place once the student arrives or be conducted over the phone prior to arrival
- CVs and motivation letters have to be sent on application
- It is recommended that students applying for an internship in a specific area have either qualifications or work experience in that field
