

Junior and school groups

DESCRIPTION:

10, 15, 16 or 20 group lessons + 3 cultural or sport activities per week + accommodation with half- or full-board Programme available year-round. Students age 14 years and up. Courses are adapted to the students' age and present level, in closed groups, led by teachers experienced in working with adolescents and young adults. In addition to grammar review, the courses employ a wide range of methods and materials: communication games, memory games, songs, audio, and extracts from magazines, newspapers and internet. Special preparation course for GCSE, A- and AS-levels, Arbitur, and AP (Advanced Placement) exams.

Accommodation and board with experienced, carefully-selected host families in Toulouse city centre. Students will be integrated into the daily life of their French family, sharing meals, outings and family activities.

Cultural and sports activities including city tours, museum visits, river cruises, concerts, excursions to local attractions ("Cit  de l'Espace - Space/Science Adventure Park), medieval cities and castles (Carcassonne, Albi, Cordes-sur-ciel), hikes in the Pyrenees, group sports such as P tanque, swimming, ice-skating and crew.

- From 10 to 20 group lessons per week in the morning - learning material included
- Half board single room accommodation with a host family in Toulouse, includes Internet access. Double room or full-board optional.
- Programme of cultural and sport activities in the afternoon (minimum 3 per week). Juniors will be accompanied by a school group leader. Half- and full-day excursions available.
- Transfer service to and from the Toulouse airport or train station
- Accident insurance on the school premises and during activities
- Attestation of participation
- Optional final examination and certificate
