Reductions on course price: long courses 5% off for 4 weeks and 10% off for 8 weeks+ - NB these do not apply to Cambridge exam courses.

There are no classes on public holidays and the weekly price will be reduced by 20% for those weeks. However, clients taking 1-1 courses may make up the time during their course when paying full week price.

Terms and conditions

We deal with a number of hotels and flat owners. This means that prices for hotel and flat accommodation are subject to availability and the final price is that given in our quotation to you. **The prices listed may be subject to change. Please check before booking.**

There are supplements for sea views, where applicable, and at Easter and Christmas time.

Payment: can be made by bank transfer on receipt of invoice or 21 days before course starts. Bank charges are to be paid by the applicant. Credit card payments are subject to 2% bank charges. Please do not email your credit card details, but send them by fax or phone them in.

Bookings made by agents may not be honoured if payment is not made in full 21 days before the students' arrival. In the case of late bookings payment must reach the college before the start of the course.

Cancellation charges: 20% 15 working days or more before course starts and 80% if cancelled after this time. Refunds will be issued within 10 days of cancellation. There will be no refunds for no-shows, absences or early departures except at the discretion of the management.

1. How do I get to Malta?

Air Malta is the National carrier yet there are flights to Malta on other airlines including budget airlines from many European cities and Dubai. Visitors from Sicily can also take a catamaran.

2. Do I need a visa for Malta?

Passport holders of *EU countries and Andorra, Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Costa Rica, Croatia, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Iceland, Israel, Japan, Lichtenstein, Malaysia, Mexico, Monaco, Nicaragua, Panama, Paraguay, Republic of Korea, San Marino, Singapore, Switzerland, Uruguay, Vatican City, Venezuela* **do not require a visa.**

Citizens of other countries can apply for a visa at their nearest Maltese Consulate or Embassy, Italian or Austrian Embassy under Schengen visa regulations.

Students will need a letter of reference from the college. Bookings and payment of fees must be made to Britannia College before this. All fees will be refunded less a € 100-charge for administrative costs if the visa is refused. Please allow 15 days for a visa to be issued.

3. Is there a course registration fee?

Registration fees are: € 50 for all general English courses & € 65 for Business English courses. This includes textbooks and other learning materials as well as a student card and course completion certificate. Registration fees are not refundable. For cancellation refunds please check the above for details. Fees are due on receipt of invoice and/or not later than 21 days before arrival.

4. Can I start a course at any time of year?

Courses - for a week or as long as you like- start Mondays* every week of the year with exception of exam and special interest courses. The dates for these will be advertised on our website in the news section. **If weekend flights are not available, you may be able to start mid-week.*

5. Can I attend an exam course even if I do not wish to sit for the exam?

Yes, though all the extra work set needs to be done if you are to benefit from the course.

6. Will I receive a certificate when completing a course?

Certificates will be issued to all students taking courses at Britannia College. All certificates are numbered and registered.

7. Are the teachers native English speakers?

Native English speakers have been selected as teachers. In any case, Britannia College only engages mature experienced tutors who more than qualify to teach all English Language skills.

8. Will I be able to keep in touch with home/my office?

Our internet café is exclusively for students' use during school opening hours and it is free of charge. All classrooms have an internet connection and laptops can be plugged in or use wifi.

9. What are the medical facilities like on Malta?

Emergency medical facilities are among the best in the world. In case of minor complaints the college will ensure you can see a doctor without delay. EU citizens are entitled to free emergency medical care. We suggest that citizens of other countries purchase insurance cover.

10. How much money do I need during a visit?

This depends on you, but here are some guidelines if you are on a tight budget:
