

Guernsey Summer Residential Programme

June 25 to July 23, 2011

Our new Guernsey summer residential programme is held at the St Margaret's Lodge Hotel, a large and comfortable two star hotel on Guernsey's south coast. Students are accommodated up to four per room, with staff and group leaders in adjoining rooms (1 per 12 students). Each room has an ensuite bathroom, storage space and television. Students are provided with a continental breakfast and two course evening meal at the hotel plus a packed lunch to eat at school. The hotel itself is ideal for organising student leisure time as it has a restaurant, two large function rooms, disco, conservatory and a large garden with pool and barbecue area.

Classes are held at a nearby private school every morning. After school, students have a full activity programme that makes the most of Guernsey's beautiful beaches and rich cultural heritage. Among the range of options available are water-sports such as surfing, windsurfing and kayaking as well as visits to important historical sites such as Castle Cornet and of course the world famous home of Victor Hugo – Hauteville House. Our residential programme also includes regular evening and weekend activities – for example Disco & Movie nights, a barbecue pool party and one full day excursion such as a day trip to the nearby island of Herm.*
